

## Important message to parents regarding planned interdisciplinary assessments at the State Diagnostic and Counselling Centre, during Covid-19

## To reduce risk of infection, we have put the following regulations into place:

- That parents and child/adolescent show up at the scheduled time
- That parents and child/adolescent do **not** come to the reception desk, but **wait in the waiting room** until a specialist comes and gets them
- That the child/adolescent's siblings do not come with them
- That only one parent accompanies the child/adolescent, unless the appointment is a consultation with parents
- That the utmost hygiene is ensured and that parents and child/adolescent wash and sanitize their hands as soon as they enter the building
- That a 2-meter distance is kept between people whenever possible
- No handshaking when greeting
- Very important: Please do not come to your scheduled appointment at the State
  Diagnostic and Counselling Centre if parents or child/adolescent have experienced
  any symptoms that could indicate a Covid-19 infection, such as flu or cold
  symptoms, bone pain, fever, dry cough, or the loss of taste and smell. Instead, please
  call 510-8400 to receive more detailed information and to reschedule. Should an
  employee become aware of a parent or child/adolescent coming to an
  appointment with any of these symptoms, they will be sent home and the
  appointment will be postponed.
